

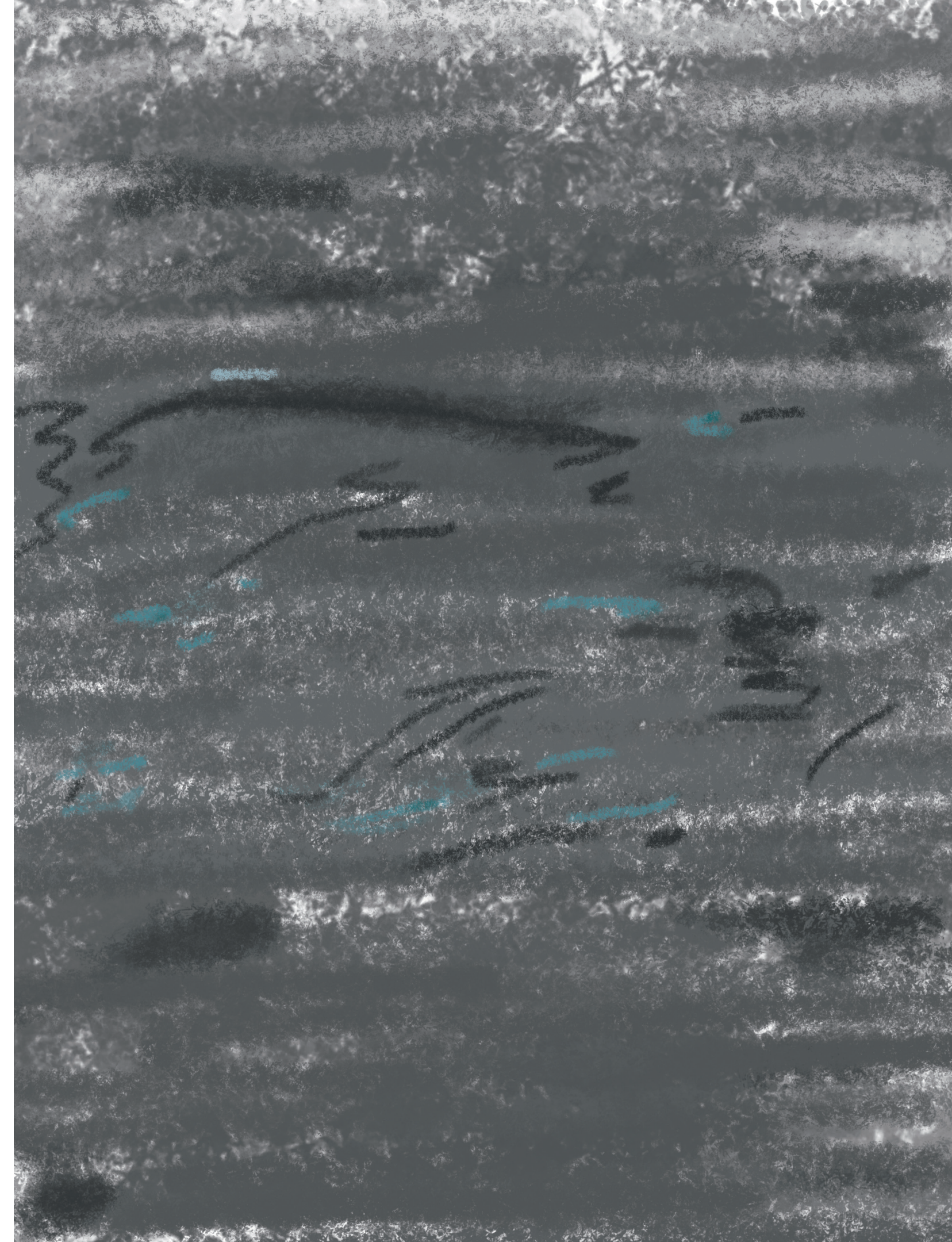
GENESIS


CHAPTER 1

The earth had no shape and was empty. The earth was also dark and mixed with deep waters.

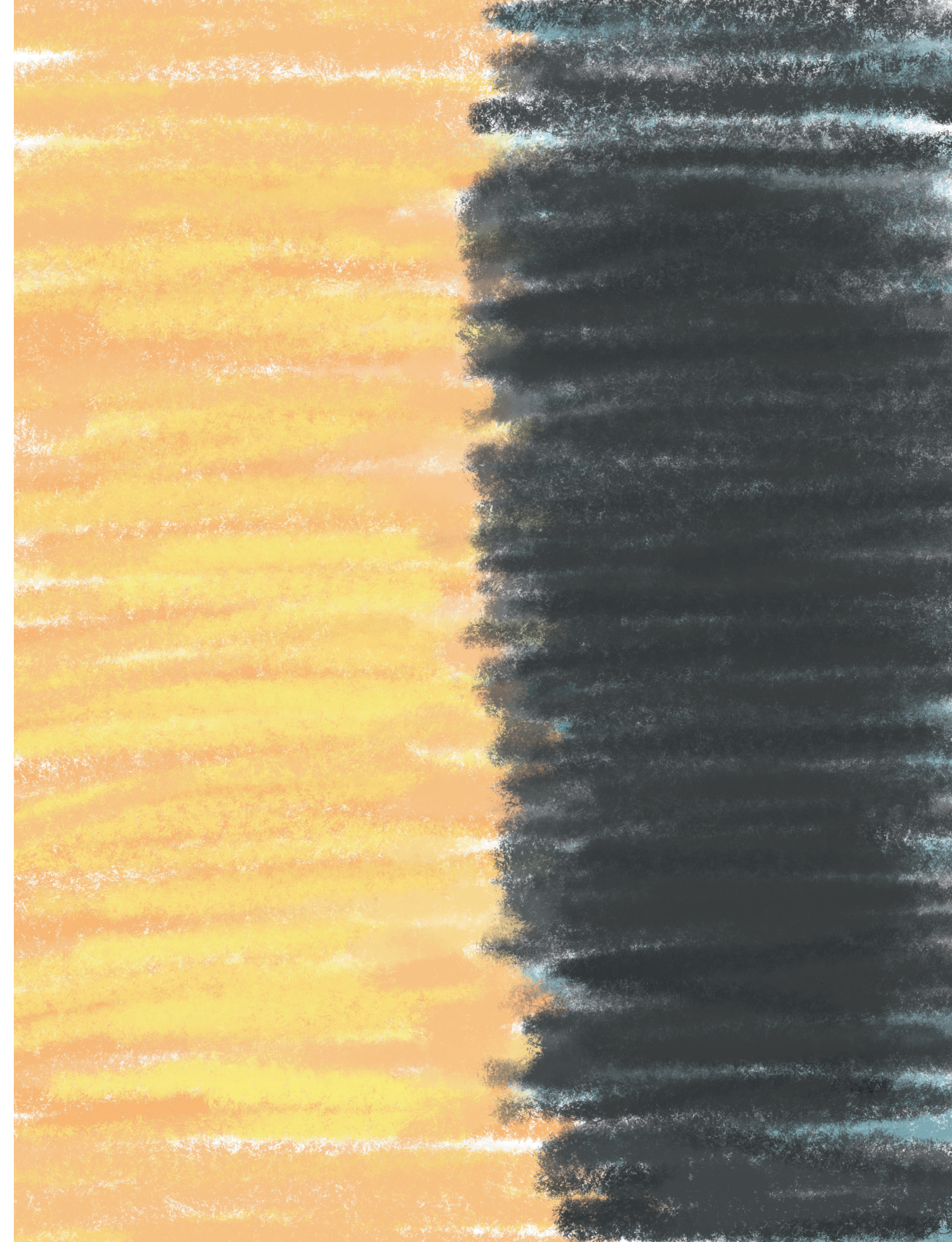




The Spirit, the breath and power of God moved over the deep waters. And God said, “Let there be light” and by God’s spoken Word, bright beautiful light appeared.

And God called the light Daytime and the darkness Nighttime. And there was evening and there was morning the first day.

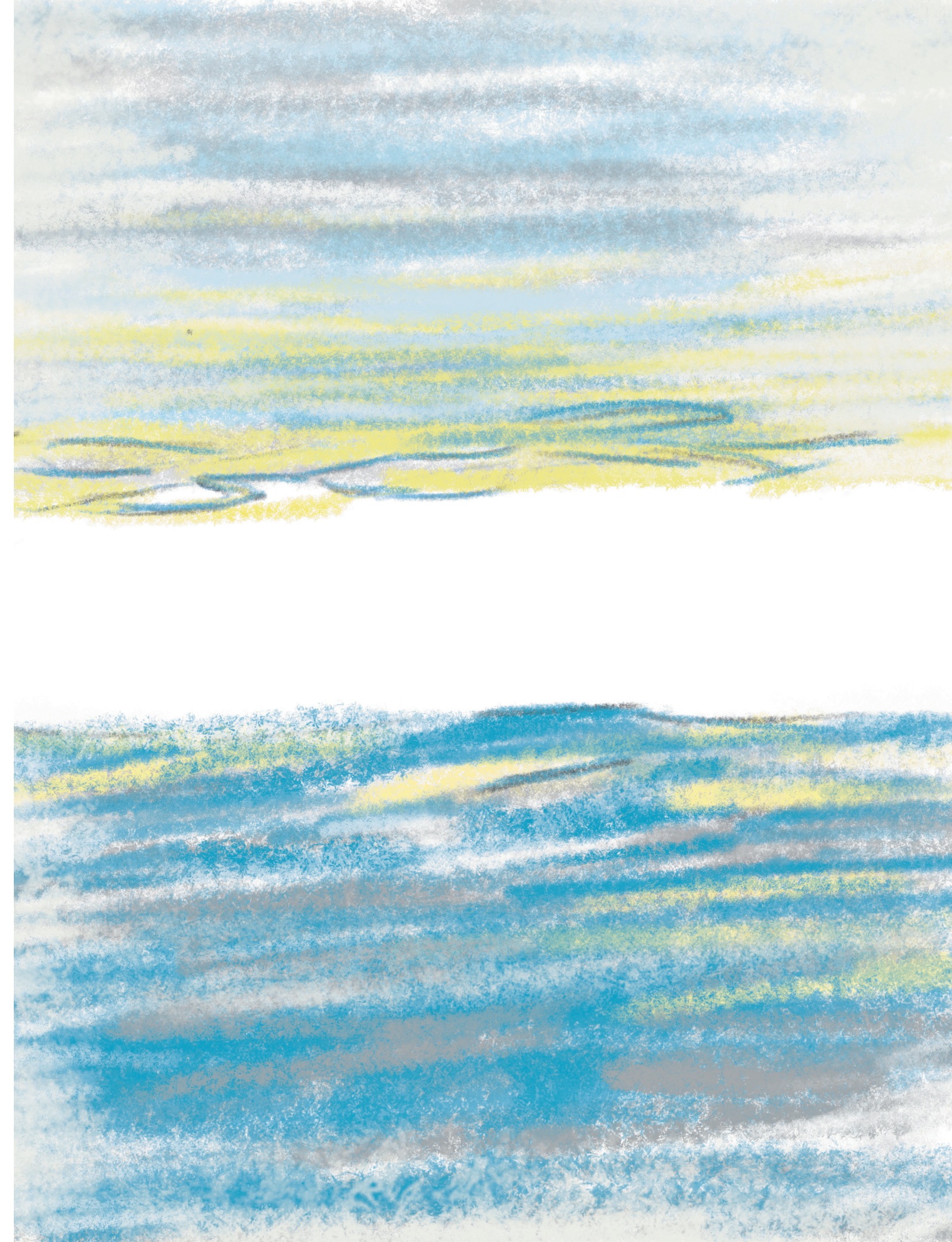


Second Day
